Material and care instructions for Textilene and Metal

Textilene – A synthetic fabric made from PVC-treated polyester. Textilene is weatherproof and can withstand exposure to the sun and rain with a little maintenance.

Steel – Used in the frames for outdoor furniture and is often powder-coated to protect against rust.

Aluminium – Used in the frames for outdoor furniture and is basically maintenance free but is powder-coated to produce the desired surface finish.

Care instructions

- Textilene Rinse/wipe the textilene with a soft brush, water and a mild detergent, such as soap. Wipe clean with a soft cloth afterwards.
- Steel Rinse/wipe the steel with a soft brush, water and a mild detergent, such as soap. Wipe clean with a soft cloth afterwards. Any rust can be removed by cleaning with a steel brush, treating it with paint cleaner and then painting it with a touch-up paint for metal.
- Aluminium Rinse/wipe the aluminium with a soft brush, water and a mild detergent, such as soap. Wipe clean with a soft cloth afterwards. Rust will not develop in any areas where the paint is damaged., but these areas can be repaired with a touch-up paint to ensure an attractive finish.
